Did you know that our neighbors in Scott County are experiencing homelessness and housing insecurity? On any given night, 139 people across Scott and Carver counties experience homelessness, many of them children. Our congregation provides hospitality to families who are experiencing homelessness through Beacon's Families Moving Forward program, but the length families stay in the program continues to increase because of a severe lack of supportive housing.

You're invited to come and learn more from local experts about what homelessness and housing insecurity looks like locally, and what our congregation can do about it. Beacon staff will share plans to create homes with support services for families like those we serve through Families Moving Forward. Come and see how our congregation can make a difference!
