



Advocacy Action for Vigil Participants

We encourage everyone holding vigil to write to their U.S. Senator and U.S. Representative, either by hand or by email.

Option 1: Write them a handwritten letter

- See the following page for postal addresses
- Writing Prompts
 - What is the vigil? What time of day is it as you are writing?
 - Why is this issue urgent and worthy of you losing sleep over it?
 - Why is supportive housing important for your community/state?
 - Any story or connection you have to an organization or a supportive housing building that is impacted.
- Talking points to include (optional)
 - Emphasize urgency and action.
 - HUD's new Continuum of Care (CoC) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) introduces sweeping structural changes that overturn decades of bipartisan progress on proven solutions to homelessness, placing thousands of Minnesotans (and 170,000 Americans) at immediate risk of losing stable housing.
 - The scale and speed of these cuts and rule changes will displace Minnesotans overcoming homelessness, leave COCs and housing providers with no time to realign programming to new guidelines, and risk destabilizing multifamily housing markets.
- Ask in your letter:
 - Please urgently include language in any appropriations bill that would require HUD to renew all CoC grants expiring in calendar year 2026 for a full year
